 - Administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
 - Administer first aid to a casualty who is choking
 - Administer first aid to a casualty who is wounded or bleeding
 - Administer first aid to a casualty that is suffering from shock
 - Provide appropriate first aid for minor injuries
