Who the course is for

This course is designed for lower risk organisations and those who are seeking a qualification in First Aid which supported by the FAIB (First Aid Industry Body).

Course content

- The importance of preventing cross infection
- The need for recording incidents and actions
- Use of available equipment
- Assess the situation and circumstances in order to act safely, promptly and effectively in an emergency situation
- Knowing how to perform the key first aid techniques:
 - Administer first aid to a casualty who is unconscious
 - Administer cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
 - Administer first aid to a casualty who is choking
 - Administer first aid to a casualty who is wounded or bleeding
 - Administer first aid to a casualty that is suffering from shock
 - Provide appropriate first aid for minor injuries
