STRIVE in Herts

We are pleased to be part of the Building Better Opportunities, STRIVE (Support and Transition Routes into Volunteering and Employment) project since 2016. Hertfordshire County Council in partnership with 20 organisations from the voluntary and community sector across Hertfordshire were successful in securing funding from The National Lottery and the European Social Fund. It aims to tackle the root causes of poverty and unemployment, such as physical and mental health issues, homelessness, addiction and much more.

All those taking part receive dedicated one-to-one support from a mentor, who guides them through the many learning and skills opportunities available through this project. It helps individuals move towards gaining work placements, volunteering opportunities or apprenticeships, employment and self-employment or into education.

The two strands of the programme are STRIVE in Hertfordshire (Barriers to Employment) and Youth Futures (Young People). All projects will continue until at least September 2021. As one of the partner/delivery organisations, the CVS for Broxbourne and East Herts (CVSBEH) is currently recruiting to a Hub Co-ordinator within the project. The BBO Project welcomes applications from all members of the community.

Within CVSBEH we have four physical hubs along with a virtual hub and the role of the BBO Strive Hub Coordinator is to oversee these hubs when they are open and to co-ordinate local services and activities within the hubs.
