Noel Park Big Local (NPBL) began in Noel Park, London N22 in 2015. Our goal is to make Noel Park a better place to live for all residents by planning and delivering resident-led initiatives that address large social issues while creating opportunities for local people.

NPBL is made up of four distinct areas, so projects need to work across all areas where appropriate. We want to add to our personnel to ensure projects and our impact can be as effective as possible. In everything we do we strive for:

- diversity and inclusion
- the cultural and linguistic diversity of the area
- the socio-economic diversity of the area
- improved social integration
- environmental sustainability

Noel Park Big Local is now looking for a dedicated **Outreach and Engagement Worker**. The Outreach and Engagement Worker will work with the resident led partnership and the Community Development Manager (appointed in December 2020) to support the implementation of the Noel Park Big Local Plan. A key part of the worker's role is to engage the community to deliver and manage projects and activities that meet local need and meet NPBL objectives to make Noel Park a better place to live. This role will also help shape the legacy for the Noel Park Big Local programme. The Noel Park programme has five priorities:

- Community Hubs and Spaces (for all age groups),
- Enterprise and employment,
- Children and Young People (including 19 to 25 year olds who are often not included),
- Older and vulnerable people,
- Improving the Local Environment,
